**1) New safety seats**

All cars entered by a Manufacturer (not including a Manufacturer team) must be fitted with homologated seats made by Racetech (homologation No. CS218.08) and/or Sparco (homologation No. CS221.08).

As limited sizes of these seats are currently available, a Manufacturer is permitted to use the previously homologated seats with 7 kg ballast added to each seat. The ballast must be fitted at a location approved by the FIA Technical Delegate.

**2) Tyres**

**Supplementary Regulations**

**Art. 6.1 – Types of tyre:**

- All 4 wd cars must use Pirelli Scorpion 205/65 Hard throughout the rally.
- Registered JWRC competitors may use any tyre detailed in WRC 2009 Sporting regulations, Appx V, Section 4.
- Non Priority competitors in 2 wd cars, may use any tyre in compliance with WRC 2009 Sporting Regulations, Appx V, Sections 1,2 & 3.

**Art. 6.3 – Quantities of tyres:**

- Priority 1 & 2 competitors may use a maximum of 46 tyres throughout the rally including Shakedown.

On Day 1, four (4) new tyres per competitor will be transported by Pirelli to Kykkos. The Pirelli truck will be positioned opposite the Fire Station approximately 50 metres after the refuelling zone of box 16, page 25 of Road Book 1.

These tyres may be used after SS1 and/or SS4 and fitted by the crew.

- Registered PWRC and Non Priority competitors in 4 wd cars may use a maximum of 24 tyres throughout the rally. An additional 5 tyres will be permitted if Shakedown is undertaken.
- Registered JWRC competitors may use a maximum of 24 tyres selected from: 10xRS5, 6xRE7 and 16xK2.
- Non Priority drivers of 2wd cars may change tyres only in the Service Park or Remote Service Zone. The quantity is unlimited.
